*The following is a list of film and video production shot in Canada in 1983. The categories are theatrical features, television features, one-hour TV programs and series of one-half hour segments or more (Canadian and foreign). Although the list is as complete as we were able to make it, we realize that there may be some omissions, especially in the "series" category where production is more difficult to follow.*

*The information given on the various productions is as follows: Title - followed by working title (w.t.) if necessary. Name of production company (p.c.) - followed by name of the production company with which the production is usually associated (in parenthesis), if appropriate. Producer (p.). Due to space and time limitations, associate producers, executive producers and various other qualified producers are not mentioned. Director (d.). (In the case of several series, a great variety of directors were used and the producer declined to provide us with all the names.) Dates of the shoot, and, in some cases, the province in which the shoot took place. A rough budget estimate of the production, when available.*

*The final line contains notes on the production's sources of funding. CRTC indicates that the production holds a Canadian content number from the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission. CFDC indicates funding from the Canadian Film Development Corp., either from the regular fund, the Broadcast Program Development Fund (BPF), or as an "interim" loan. IQC indicates funding from the Institut québécois du cinéma. Names of television networks or pay stations indicate that the companies were involved in the production, but there is no indication as to whether the involvement is in the nature of a pre-sale, a pick-up, or a broadcast commitment. Where possible, we have also indicated when a programme was taped as opposed to filmed. Finally CCA indicates that the project has received provisional certification as a Canadian film or program for the Canadian Film and Videotape Certification Office of the department of Communications, Ottawa.*
