
Boys and Girls was also successful as a CBC Television program, broadcast earlier this year in the acclaimed Sons and Daughters series.

And The Profession of Arms, another NFB production, produced by Michael Bryans and Tina Viljoen, was aired in last year's War series on CBC Television.


