Projects are separated into four categories: ON LOCATION, PREPRODUCTION, IN NEGOTIATION, and IN THE CAN. While the status of projects are subject to change, only those in active preproduction at the time of publication - those which have set a date for principal photography and are also engaged in casting and crewing - are listed under PRE-PRODUCTION.

The IN NEGOTIATION section is published every other month due to lack of turnover in projects. Films are listed by the name of the company which initiated the project, or by the company that is popularly associated with it. The production company is not necessarily the same company which initiated or is associated with the project. When two companies are different, the name of the production company, if known, is given.

If producers ask us not to list certain credits because of ongoing negotiations, we respect their request.


