The following is a list of film and video productions shot in Canada in 1984. The categories are theatrical features, television features, one-hour TV programs and series of one-half hour segments or more (Canadian and foreign). Although the list is as complete as we were able to make it, we realize that there may be some omissions, especially in the "series" category where production is more difficult to follow. Nor, given the intricacies of multi-partner financing, has it always been possible to determine with complete accuracy whether a feature is indeed for theatrical or television release.

The information given on the various productions is as follows: **Title** - followed by working title (w.t.) if necessary. Name of **production company** (p.c.). **Producer** (p.). Due to space and time limitations, associate producers, executive producers and various other qualified producers are not mentioned. **Director** (d.). (In the case of several series, a great variety of directors were used and the producer declined to provide us with all the names.) **Dates** of the shoot, and, in some cases, the province in which the shoot took place. A rough **budget** estimate of the production, when available.

The final line contains notes on the production's sources of funding, whether an investment, a pre-sale, a broadcasting license, etc. Common abbreviations are as follows: AMPDC-Alberta Motion Picture Development Corp. CBC-Canadian Broadcasting Corp. RQ-Radio-Québec, SGC-Société Générale du Cinéma, SRC-Société Radio-Canada, TF-Telefilm. An asterisk following the title of production indicates certification as a Canadian program either by the department of Communications or by the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC).

## Erratum

In last month's Cinema Canada, the news story entitled "NFB loses CRTC bid for pay kids' net" erroneously reported that Michael G. Rinaldo's application for a network license for an English-language health and lifestyle specialty service had been turned down by the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) prior to the Feb. 5 hearing in Ottawa on youth, family and health specialty pay-TV license applications. In fact, it was the Canadian Health Network's application, and not Michael Rinaldo's, that was turned down by the CRTC. Mr. Rinaldo's application was heard before the Commission as scheduled, while all other applications pertaining to youth and family-oriented specialty services were postponed pending further public consultation.
